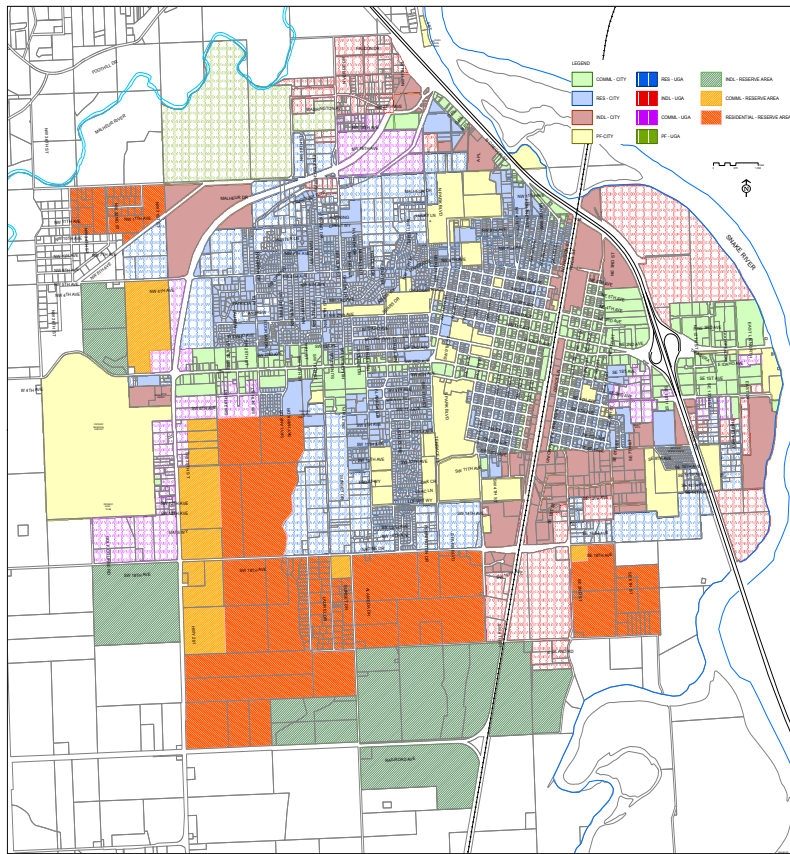


Figure: City of Ontario, Comprehensive Plan showing URA

Winterbrook worked with ECONorthwest to prepare population projections, housing and economic studies, BLIs, and comprehensive plan policy and map amendments necessary to justify the 2056 Ontario URA. Winterbrook coordinated with the City of Ontario and Malheur County in the public review and adoption process involving a Technical Advisory Committee, both Planning Commissions, the City Council and County Court.

In May – June of 2007, the City and County adopted a new comprehensive plan, population forecasts and background studies, and detailed findings necessary to justify URA expansion. In July of 2007, the City and County Planning Commissions met in joint session and unanimously recommended adoption of the URA amendment package that included interim development standards and a revised intergovernmental agreement with Malheur County. Elected officials adopted the URA amendment package in September of 2007. The URA expansion was acknowledged by LCDC the same year.
